### Internal Assessment

Periodic test (Unit tests/Revision tests)	= 3 marks
Multiple Assessments (Oral test, concept map, quiz, seminar etc.)	= 2 marks

Subject enrichment activities (ASL, Project, Practical work)	= 3 marks

#### Student Portfolio:

- Each student has to do portfolio to monitor his/her own learning, redirect his efforts and set future goals.
- The portfolio can be done together for all the 5 subjects for a year.
- The content of the portfolio would be:
  - Cover page
  - Self-introduction
  - Strength and weakness
  - Subject wise division:
    - Efforts taken (class work, homework, assignments)
    - Progress and growth (Marks obtained in various assessments/quiz/exams)
    - Achievements (special prizes/ certificates won related with the subject)
- The portfolio work can be begun in Term I and completed by 24<sup>th</sup> of December 2021.
- The subject teachers will evaluate the ongoing process of portfolio during the end of Term I and evaluate the completed one in Term II.
- Criteria for evaluation:
  - Neatness and visual appeal
  - Completion of guided work
  - Evidences of students' growth
  - Inclusion of all relevant work
- The students can maintain the portfolio in folders, stick files or in files and completed one should be submitted to the class teachers as a bound one (spiral binding).
- A model portfolio is posted in the WhatsApp.

### Objective:

- The overall objective of the project work is to help students gain an insight and pragmatic understanding of the theme and see all the Social Science disciplines from interdisciplinary perspective.
- It should also help in enhancing the Life Skills of the students.
- Students are expected to apply the Social Science concepts that they have learnt over the years in order to prepare the project report.
- If required, students may go out for collecting data and use different primary and secondary resources to prepare the project.
- If possible, various forms of art may be integrated in the project work.

### Content:

- Cover Page
- Index
- Objectives
- Subtopics
  - Introduction of the topic
  - Present situation about the issue
  - Facts and figures
  - Case study (real incident happened)
  - Suggestions and solutions
- Acknowledgement
- Bibliography

### Evaluation:
