Vengamma, Director-cum-Vice-Chancellor, S.V.I.M.S., Tirupati, esteemed guests of the day, parents, well-wishers, teaching and non-teaching staff and my dear children, a warm welcome to everyone gathered here today. With the belief that the children are the citizens of tomorrow, we pave way for their bright future and holistic development. Bhavan aims to motivate students to be life-long learners, critical thinkers and productive members of the ever-changing global society. Let me take the privilege to present an overview of multifarious activities of our school. Some were conducted online virtually and a few were conducted offline for the Academic Year 2021-22, to this august gathering.

ACADEMICS

In the All India Secondary School Examination conducted by C.B.S.E. in March, 2021, for the 24th consecutive year, our school has achieved 100% pass percentage. Out of 168 students who appeared for the examination, 65 students secured 90% and above, 162 students passed in Distinction and 6 passed in I Class. Mas.S.Mokshith Srinivas got 495 out of 500 and got the I Rank at school level in A.I.S.S.E. 2021. Kum. K. Sharika and Mas.U.Bharath Sarma got the II and III Ranks by securing 491 and 490 Marks out of 500 respectively.

In the All India Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by C.B.S.E. in March, 2021, the 3rd Batch of Senior Secondary Classes passed with 100% pass percentage. 17 students appeared for the examination, in which all 17 students passed with Distinction.

Kum. P. Nischala secured the 478 out of 500 and stood in the I Rank at school level in A.I.S.S.C.E., 2021 and Mas.K.H.Gopala Krishnan secured 477 out of 500 and stood in the Second Place at school level and Kum. E. Purvitha and Mas. K. Aditya Varma got 476 out of 500 and stood in the III Place.

Kum. P. Nischala got seat in I.I.T., Varanasi. Kum.Geethanjali Nagari got admission in Bachelor of Arts in Management Sciences and Quantitative Methods in George Mason University, Virginia, U.S.A. Kum. S. Bhavyasree and Kum.J.Dheera got selected in C.L.A.T. Examination and joined in Andhra University and Symbiosis, Pune respectively. Mas.A.Aditya Hitesh joined in I.I.S.E.R., Tirupati.

INFRASTRUCTURE

A Synthetic Tennis Court worth Rs. 16 lakhs was inaugurated on 20th September, 2021 and nearly 30 students have enrolled for coaching.

SPECIAL ACHEIVEMENTS OF THE SCHOOL

The Principal, Smt. S. Indira, of the school is appointed as the City Co-ordinator of all 34 C.B.S.E. schools of Chittoor District for the 3rd consecutive year by the Regional Office, C.B.S.E., Chennai. Our school is selected as the Lead Collaborator of Hubs of Learning by Centre of Excellence in C.B.S.E. under which 9 C.B .S.E. schools will be participating in all activities – both curricular and co-curricular.

Smt. K. Leelavathi and Smt. N.B. Saroja have attended Online Training Programme on Leadership and Management of Early Childcare and Education on 21st and 22nd December, 2021, organized by Bhavan's Research Centre, Kochi.

Many of the teachers are undergoing training on Nisitha courses and Ekalavya Series conducted throughout the year.

Smt. L. Poornima, School Counsellor, conducted a Workshop on Kendriya Vidyalaya – I, Tirupati, for XI and XII students on the topic ‘Educational Guidance and Counselling’ under the programme of Hubs of Learning.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The new Library of 2700 sq.ft. has come functional this academic year. Our Library has 14,864 general books, 200 reference books, 92 dictionaries, 6084 textbooks, 24 multimedia CDs, 15 periodicals and 6 newspapers. The Library is automated with Pupilpod software. Class Library system is functioning from Class I to III under the monitorship of class teachers. All classes together have 1,480 books. The Library Week was organized from 14th November to 20th November, 2021. Various competitions were held during the week for the students of IV to IX. Readers Club Members have special privilege of taking extra books from the Library using Readers Club Card.

C.B.S.E. Activities

As per the instructions of C.B.S.E., our school took part in Swachh Bharat, Swachh Paryatan, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Swachhta Pakhwada, Ek Bharat – Sresth Bharat, Fit India Freedom Run 2.0, Rastriya Poshan Maa, Vigilance Awareness Day, Public Outreach Programme against Drug, C.B.S.E. Science Challenge – 2022 and C.B.S.E. Reading Campaign. Under Ek Bharat – Sresth Bharat, a Toy Mela was conducted on 11th and 12th October, 2021 to highlight the diversity culture of India with more emphasis on Andhra Pradesh and our pair state Punjab.

Under Fit India Quiz contest, D. Nikhil of Class XI and G. Ashwin of Class XII got the 4th and 6th Rank respectively and got qualified for the next level. They got the cash award of Rs. 1000 each by C.B.S.E. Our school was selected one of the top 360 schools in the country.
