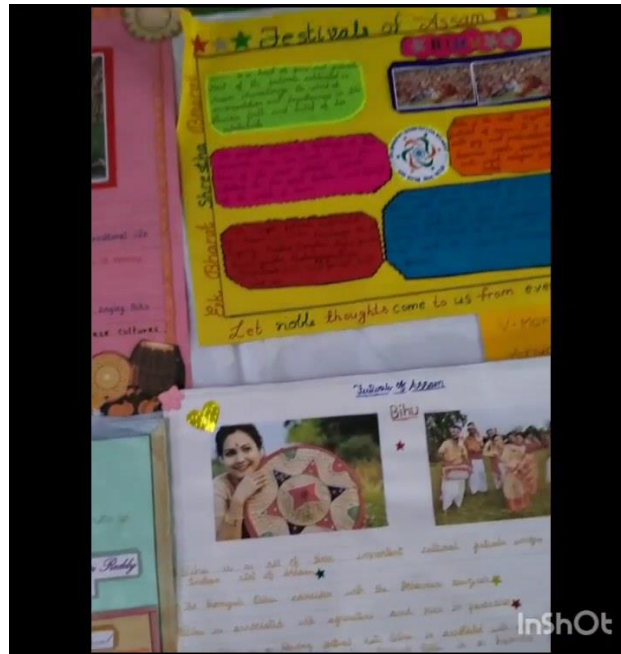






## Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat

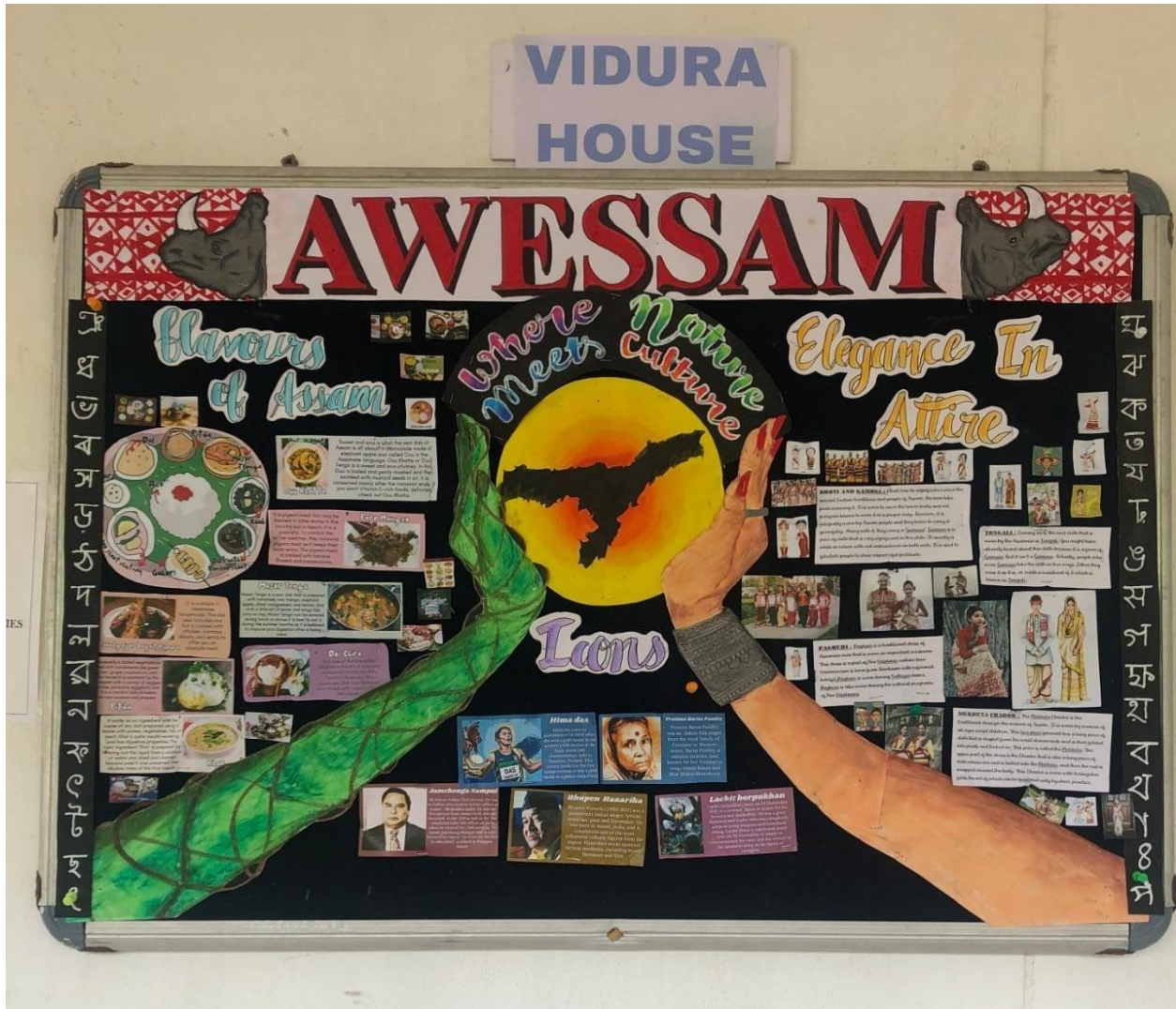

Alluri Sitarama Raju father. Venkata Rama Raju, was a professional photographer who settled in the town of Rajahmundry for his vocation. His mother Surya Varayanamma, was a pious homemaker. He was given the title 'Manyam Veerudu' Hero of the Jungle.




Alluri Sitarama Raju was an Indian revolutionary who waged an armed campaign against the British colonial rule. He was involved in opposing the British in response to the 1882 Madras Non-cooperation movement led to the Rampa rebellion in which Alluri Sitarama Raju played the major role as its leader.

His date of birth is disputed with some sources repeating it as 4 July 1897. Alluri Sitarama Raju was born into a Telugu speaking family. The British eventually managed to capture Alluri in the forests of Chintapalle.

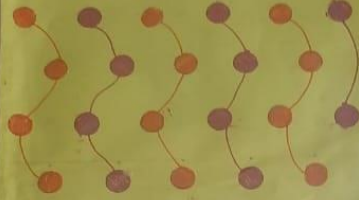

For further studies he went to Visakhapatnam at the age of 18. He pursued his school and university education.

## Annual Sports Day - 29th Aug

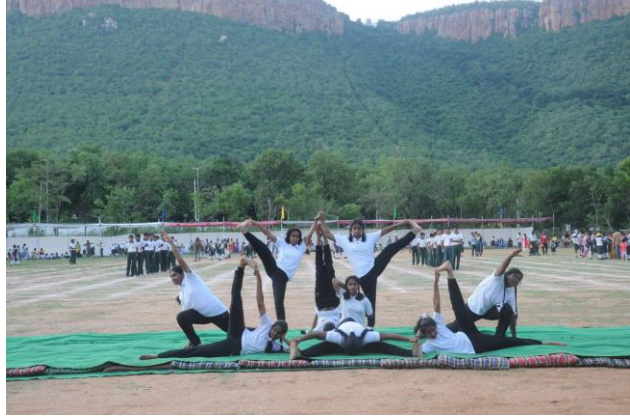

***Mock Election in the classroom***



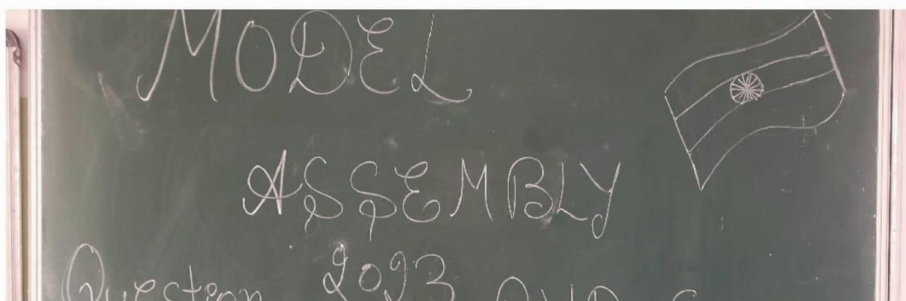

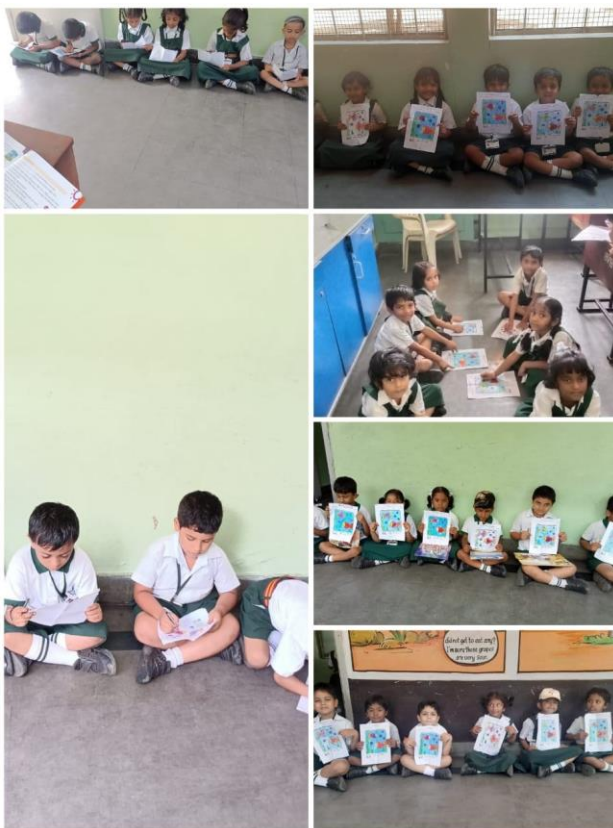






## Co-curricular competition
