


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Students Awareness Programme























Bound for Glory -


She has got 'Best Performer in Bowling' in women's cricket at Zonal level.










4 - The Eco Drive board has sought tips from students on maintaining an eco-friendly environment. The student apex body collected pictures and articles, which they then showcased on the board.







