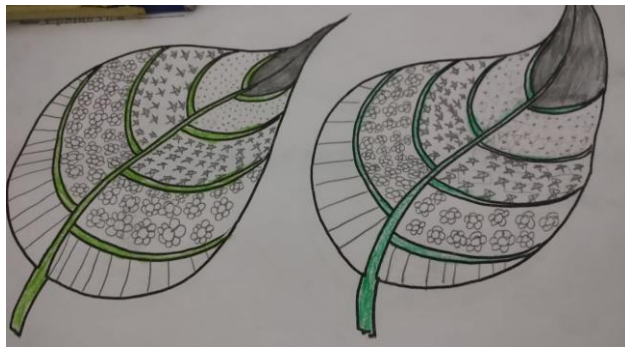
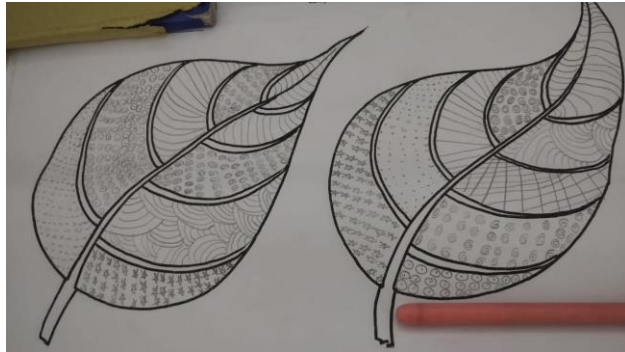

assess the entries, and the most outstanding ones will be honored during our upcoming School Annual Day celebration.



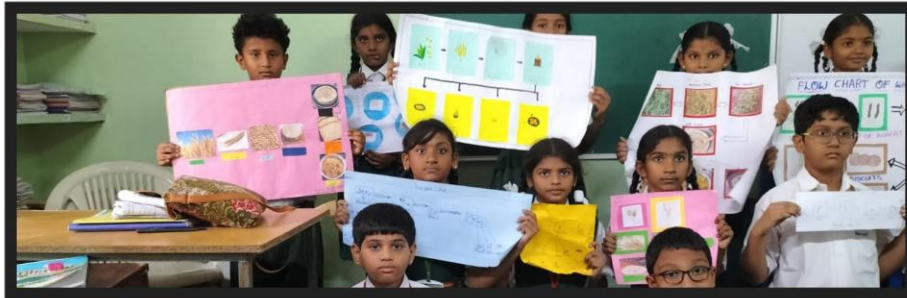

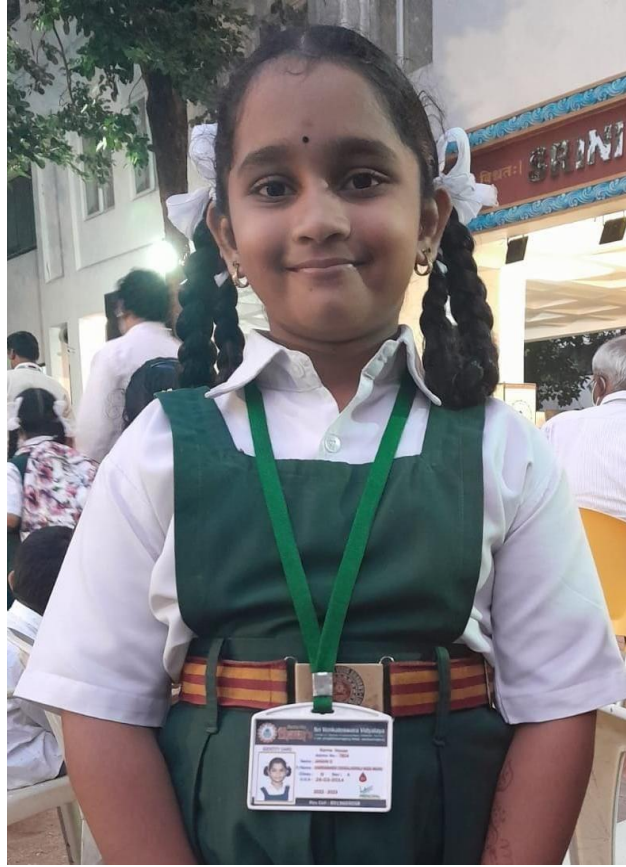



Vanisree, Principal and Sri S V Seshavataram CBSE Coordinator have attended the programme along with our Academic Advisor.







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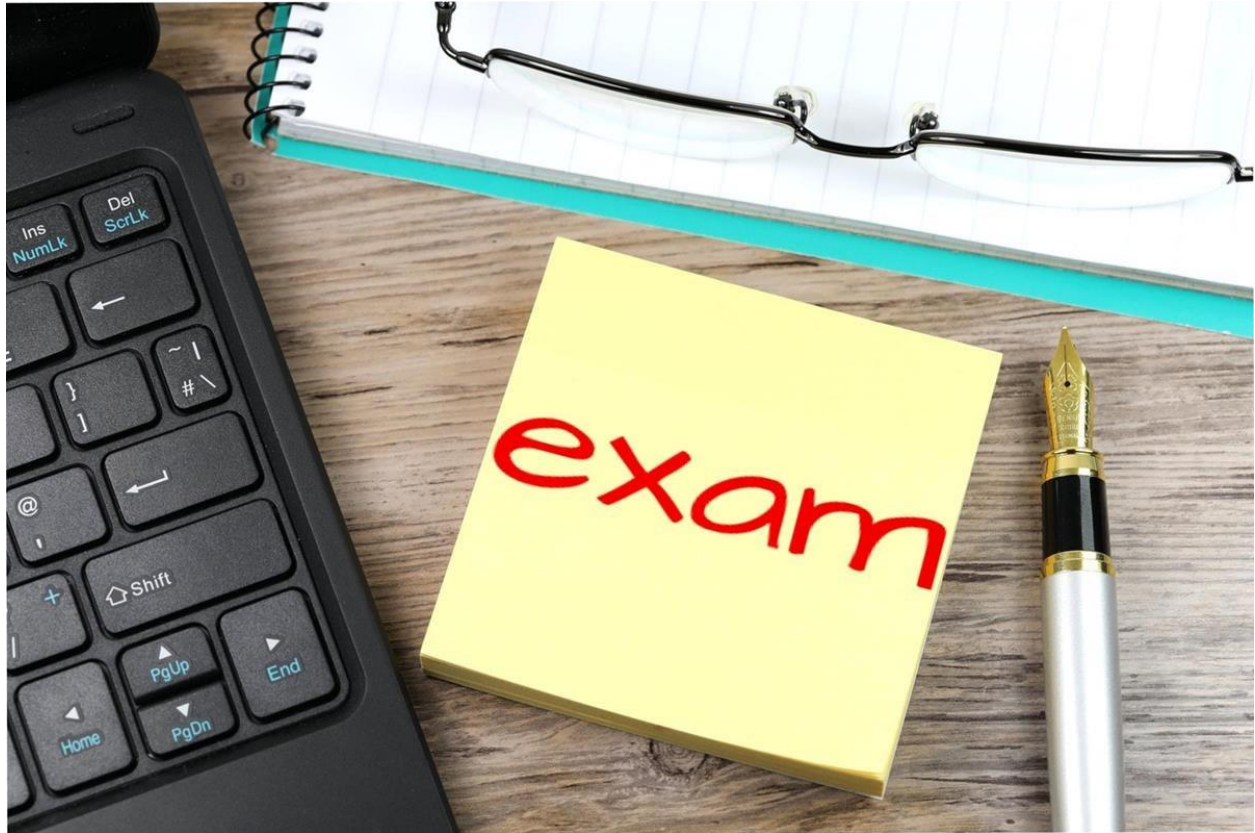
