# Namaste everyone!

With the belief that children are the torchbearers of tomorrow, our mission is to instill the passion for continuous learning, the ability to think critically and the capacity to contribute meaningfully to the ever evolving global community. Let me take the privilege to present and over view of multifarious activities of our school for the academic year 2023-24, to this august gathering.

#### **ACADEMICS**

In the All India Secondary School Examination conducted by C.B.S.E. in March 2023, for the 26th consecutive year, our school has achieved 100% pass percentage. Out of 186 students who appeared for the examination, 43 students secured 90% and above, 78 students passed in distinction, 47 students passed in 1st Class and 18 students passed in 2nd Class. Kum. Geethamrutha Kalakada and Mas.Puneeth Shekar Reddy Birudala secured 495 out of 500 and got the First Rank at the school level. Kum. V. Ruthika Reddy secured the Second Rank by scoring 493 marks and Mas. Surya Vardhan Jagadeeshwar got the Third Rank by securing 491 marks.

In the All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination conducted by C.B.S.E. in March 2023, the 5<sup>th</sup> Batch of Senior Secondary Classes passed with 97% pass percentage. 36 students appeared for the examination in which 17 students passed with distinction and 18 students passed in 1<sup>st</sup> Class.

Mas. S Ganesh scored 473 out of 500 and secured the first rank in the Science Stream at the school level and Kum. T S Lasitha Reddy scored 461 and secured the  $2^{nd}$  rank and Mas. Aswin Kumar Ganti scored 438 and secured  $3^{rd}$  rank.

Kum. R Sathyaa scored 483 out of 500 and secured the 1<sup>st</sup> rank in the Commerce Stream at the school level, Kum. G Deepthi scored 473 marks and Kum. Aparna Das scored 441 securing 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rank respectively.

Our school has been selected as one of the schools for SAFAL Pilot Programme for the students of classes 3,5 and 8.

### \*\*Collaboration with Times of India and The Hindu\*\*

Our school takes pride in fostering a dynamic learning environment through collaboration with prominent newspapers like Times of India and The Hindu. Under the innovative 'Newspaper in Education' programme, the school editions of these newspapers have been integrated as valuable teaching and learning materials in our classrooms. This initiative not only enhances students' reading skills but also provides real-world insights and diverse perspectives, enriching their educational experience.

# \*\*Collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society\*\*

In alignment with our commitment to holistic education and community engagement, our school has become an officially registered partner of the Indian Red Cross Society. Around 150 students from classes 8 and 9 have become the members of the society. This collaborative effort empowers our students to become responsible and compassionate citizens.

## **Orientation Programmes**

Teacher orientation programmes offer an opportunity to enhance pedagogical knowledge and implement effective instructional strategies.

A 3-day In-service training programme was organized by Bhavan's Tirupati from 6<sup>th</sup> June to 8<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in which all the teachers participated. Eminent resource persons shared insights on teacher professional development in the context of rapidly changing world.

An informative Cyber Crime Awareness Programme was organized for all the teachers.

On account of 8<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations of The Ramakrishna Mission Tirupati a workshop was organized and 20 teachers from our vidyalaya participated in it.

3 teachers participated in a specialized capacity building programme organized by CBSE on gender sensitivity hosted at Delhi Public School Tirupati.

An orientation programme was conducted for the students of classes VII and VIII on 'Physical hygiene and behavior management including anger and anxiety issues'.

Nearly 13 teachers from the science department attended a workshop conducted by Regional Science Center Tirupati.

Almost 60 teachers of the school attended a one day capacity building programme on NEP.

# **School Library**

Our school library is a treasure trove of knowledge, boasting 15,623 general books, 260 reference books, 92 dictionaries, 24 multimedia CDs, and subscriptions to 20 periodicals and 5 newspapers. This extensive collection caters to diverse academic needs and encourages a culture of reading among students.

A well-organized class library system operates from classes 1 to 3, closely monitored by class teachers.

In line with our commitment to promoting literacy and the joy of reading, our school celebrated Library Week from 14th to 20th November 2023. Various competitions were organized, creating a vibrant atmosphere that aimed to instill a passion for reading in a world dominated by gadgets.

## **Competitive Examinations**

The competitive exam allows children to believe in themselves, put in necessary hard work and move forward to prepare the trajectory of their careers.

To enhance the skill set and learning process, around 20 competitive exams were conducted in which 1700 students have participated in various levels.

Olympiad exams at all levels, Ramanuja Math Exam, Aryabhatta Ganith Challenge, Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan, National Talent Search Examination, All India Maths Science Examination, IFSE's Global ELT are to mention a few.

S.K. Durgesh of Class XII and G. Sri Sathvi of Class X C secured Gold Medals in the Global ELT Examination.

#### **Club Activities**

Balaram (Grade 8) and G. Himasree (Grade 7) showcased exceptional talent by participating in the state-level round, representing our school with distinction.

During a month long Children Science Festival, our students presented a project designed to enhance the effectiveness of tasks for visually challenged.

Sonakshi Gupta of Class 9 participated in Karate Open World Cup 2023 and secured I Position in Individual Kumite under 14 years category.

In the 67<sup>th</sup> SGF National Archery Championship 2023-24 Mas.Sutej Reddy of class 11 won bronze medal.
