I now take the privilege of presenting a plethora of our activities during the Academic Year 2025–2026.

ACADEMICS

In the **All India Secondary School Examination** conducted by C.B.S.E. in March 2025, for the 28th consecutive year, our school has achieved 100% pass percentage. Out of **172** students who appeared for the examination, **25** students secured **90%** and above, **77** students passed with **Distinction**, **46** students passed in **I Class** and **23** students passed in **II Class**.

Kum. Avala Keerthika Reddy secured **481** out of **500** and got the **I Rank** at the school level. **Kum. Jakkamsetty N.V.S. Sarvani** secured the **II Rank** by scoring **477** marks and **Kum. Arisetti Sadhana** got the **III Rank** by securing **475** marks.

In the **All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination** conducted by C.B.S.E. in March 2025, the **7th Batch** of **Senior Secondary** students passed with **100%** pass percentage. **58** students appeared for the examination in which **31** students passed with **Distinction** and **24** students passed in **I Class**.

Kum. Amrita Sachan scored **450** out of 500 and secured the **I Rank** in the **Science Stream** at the school level and the **II Rank** was shared by **Mas. Takkila Navdeep** and **Mas. Mantri Raghupati** with a score **443** out of 500, and **Kum. Dondla Chetan Varsha** scored **439** and secured **III Rank**.

Kum. Vutukuru Ruthika Reddy scored **488** out of 500 and secured the **I Rank** in the **Commerce Stream** at the school level, **Kum. K.R.S. Dhakshitha** scored **435** marks and **Mas. T. Lohith Siddharth** scored **408** securing **II** and **III Rank** respectively.

ORIENTATION PROGRAMMES

Teacher Orientation programmes aims to improve teaching skill and update knowledge of subjects among teachers. With the objective to promote new teaching methods and encourage teamwork among teachers, orientation programmes and workshops are conducted.

An In-service teacher's training programme was organised in Bhavan's Tirupati Kendra on 6th June, 2025 and all the teaching staff participated in it.

On 3rd and 4th October 2025, a Two-day Capacity Building Programme was organised by C.B.S.E. focussing on Strengthening Assessment and Education Practices.

B.Vasantha, P.G.T in Mathematics attended a 3-day webinar series on Innovating skills and Learning for Mathematics Educators.

A 2-day training of trainer's course to be a recognized resource person of C.B.S.E. was attended by 5 of our teachers namely Dr P. Sowjanya, Smt. R. Mahalakshmi, Mr. P. Tirupal, Smt. T. Sreevani, Smt. A.D.Vidya Lakshmi and Mr. S.V. Seshavataram.

INTER-SCHOOL COMPETITIONS

Competitive examinations play a significant role in fostering academic excellence, self-discipline, and a healthy spirit of competition among students. They provide opportunities for students to assess their abilities, develop critical thinking skills, and prepare for future academic pursuits.

During the academic year 2025–26, a total number of 22 competitive examinations were conducted with the objective of enhancing students' skills and strengthening the learning process. Nearly 1700 students participated in these examinations at various levels.

In State wise SOF Commerce Olympiad, 4 members received gold medals of excellence and 2 members received gold medals of distinction.

In Ramanujan Math Olympiad, 82 students participated of which 11 students were qualified for 2nd level and 6 students got prizes

Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan was conducted in the month of November. Out of 30 students participated, 23 students are qualified for the second level and 3 students namely D.C. Balaram, G. Vishnu Teja of Grade X, and Bhavan Krishna Reddy of Grade IX are selected for state camp.

Bhagavad Gita recitation competition was organized on 14th and 21st September, 2025 by Chinmaya Mission. 434 students from our school participated out of which 32 won the I Prize, 32 got II Prize and the remaining stood in the III position.

In the **First Spell Bee Competition**, organized on 30th October, 2025, by Spell Bee International Private Limited, Chennai, 133 students participated. 21 students won the topper medals and the remaining got distinction and merit certificates.

Karthik Srihan of V Grade secured IX Rank in National Level Spell Bee Competition.

Fourth Tirupati Balotsav was conducted on 2nd and 3rd November, 2025. 120 students participated, 33 students secured I Prize, 20 students got II Prize and 15 got III Prize.

On the eve of Janmastami, I.S.K.C.O.N. organized various competitions on 16th August, 2025, to promote and propagate Indian culture. In this cultural fest nearly 60 students took part and won prizes.

Deen Dayal Sparsh Yojana by Postal Department conducted State level Philately competition on "India's relations with other countries" in which T. Suhanth of Grade VI got I Prize and received Rs. 6000/- as scholarship.

On the occasion of National Youth Day, Rama Krishna Mission Ashrama organised various competitions to the students, in which M.G.

Hiresh Krishna of Grade VI secured I Prize in Drawing Competition and Joviyasree of Grade IX won consolation prize in the Elocution competition.

SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENTS

Around 20 schools participated under Sub-Juniors category, out of which 3 students from our school bagged prizes.

A. Dola Nandini of Grade VIII secured IV Prize.

Yogasana Championship for boys was organised by C.B.S.E. South Zone from 15th August to 17th August at Lakshya School, Kakinada, East Godavari District, A.P.
